FY2022-23 Long Bill

In response to this year's Long Bill HB22-1329, the Office of the State Architect, with close coordination with the Office of the State Controller has posted the <u>SLFRF Interim Policy</u>, requisite <u>SLFRF Supplementary General Conditions</u> and <u>SLFRF Terms and Conditions</u> to the State Buildings Program website.

We apologize it has taken so long to provide a policy to help guide us through the process. We ask that all project managers review all three documents for greater understanding of the additional solicitation and contract requirements.

Please continue to be patient as the Federal Department of Treasury may update their requirements for the State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) of which the Long Bill is a part of, at any time. OSA will respond as quickly as we can when this occurs.

The State Controller's OSC Alerts and their <u>American Rescue Plan Act website</u> also contains a wealth of references and training regarding both general federal grant requirements and specific policy information for ARPA, State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds and the Revenue Loss Restoration Cash Fund.
