SLFRF Long Bill (HB22-1329) Encumbrance Extension

The CDC, OSPB and the State Controller have granted, per OSA's request, an additional 6 months to the 6-month encumbrance rule ONLY for projects appropriated in the last Long Bill (HB22-1329). As you may recall, these are the projects that were primarily funded with SLRLF funds. The date has been extended from October 25, 2022 to **April 25, 2023**. Please make certain you have identified all of your deadlines under the federal regulations - they are NOT the same as the state's deadline. You will have much less time to complete your projects.

This was granted based on the following:

On September 2, 2022, the Capital Development Committee (CDC) considered a request to extend the six-month encumbrance deadline to a twelve-month encumbrance deadline for all capital projects funded with Revenue Loss Restoration Funds, pursuant to Section 24-30-1404 (7), C.R.S. The CDC approves the waiver requests to the Office of the State Controller. This applies to all projects in the FY 2022-23 Long Bill, excepting certain highway construction projects and lease-purchase payments.
