SUBJECT: SLFRF Funding Swap / Gender Neutral Restroom Signage

I. SLFRF FUNDING SWAP

With the passing of HB24-1466, SLFRF Funding Swap, most projects originally funded by Federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund in HB22-1329 and SB23-214 have been modified to have all or some of the funding moved to General Fund.

- a. The General Fund portion of the swap is available as described in Fiscal Rule 4-2 3.1.3 “Appropriated Capital Construction Funds are available immediately upon signature of the Governor, as current year appropriations. Appropriated Capital Construction Projects must be initiated by the end of the fiscal year following the original appropriation and will remain available for expenditure or Encumbrance for a period of three years or until completion of the Project, whichever is first.
 - HB22-1329 must be fully encumbered June 30, 2025
 - SB23-214 must be fully encumbered June 30, 2026
- b. The Office of the State Controller has developed the Funding Source Change Letter that must be used for all contracts refinanced under HB24-1466. Use of any other modification tool is not permitted. Please download and save the Funding Source Change Letter to your computer before generating completed documents. In addition, download and save the Cover Letter. The Cover Letter should be sent to each subrecipient or contractor receiving a Funding Source Change Letter.

- c. The fund swap list is attached as Final Capital Construction Numbers in HB-1466.

II. GENDER NEUTRAL RESTROOM REQUIREMENTS OF HB23-1057

- a. There are three deadlines related to this bill:
 - (1) On or After January 1, 2024: A building that is wholly or partially owned by a Public Entity that is scheduled for renovation of a restroom must:

- Provide a non-gendered single-stall restroom or non-gendered multi-stall restroom where a restroom is accessible to the public.
- Ensure that any single-stall restroom is not a gender specific restroom
- Provide an infant diaper changing station where a restroom is accessible to the public
- If only gender specific restrooms are available, provide at least one changing table in each restroom
- Or provide a diaper changing station in an easily accessible location with equivalent privacy and amenities as a restroom. At a minimum, privacy, trash receptacle and a handwashing sink and hand drying capabilities shall be provided.

(2a) On and After July 1, 2025: (2.a) A building that is accessible to employees or enrolled students that is scheduled for a restroom renovation:

- Shall provide a non-gendered single-stall restroom or non-gendered multi-stall restroom where a restroom is accessible to the public.
- Ensure that any single-stall restroom is not a gender specific restroom

(2.b) A newly constructed building must provide the following on each floor:

- A non-gendered single-stall restroom or non-gendered multi-stall restroom where a restroom accessible to the public.
- Ensure that any single-stall restroom is not a gender specific restroom

Exceptions for deadlines #1 and #2 are:

- if a code consultant deems the baby changing stations would negate other applicable building codes
- the project has already progressed through the design review process, budgeting, and final approval by the governing body that has final approval over capital construction project expenditures as of the effective date of this subsection (5)(b), as enacted by house bill 23-1057 (by August 6, 2023)
- the building is a designate historic structure

(3) Beginning July 1, 2024 but no later than July 1, 2026: A building that is owned or leased by a public entity must ensure that signage for the building, or the leased portion of the building is provided as follows:

- Any restroom with a baby diaper changing station must have signage with a pictogram void of gender.
- Each building that is accessible to the public must include signage at or near the entrance to the building indicating the location of gender neutral restrooms and baby diaper changing stations.
 - This should be included on any existing directories wherever possible.
- All restrooms accessible to the public with non-gendered restrooms must have signage with a pictogram void of gender.

b. Gender Neutral Restroom Signage

In order to assist in complying with C.R.S. § 9.5-7-103(3) of having non-gender signage on all existing non-gendered multi-stall restrooms, single gendered restrooms and baby changing station locations, State Buildings has created Gender Neutral Signage Request Procedures (SBP-GNSP).

c. The requirements of the bill are also included in the OSA Code Compliance Policy, Amendments to the ICC Chapter 29.

COLORADO GENDER NEUTRAL SIGNAGE REQUEST PROCEDURES:

I. PURPOSE

With the passing of HB23-1057, C.R.S. § 9.5-7-103(3) requires that by July 1, 2026 owned or leased State buildings must:

- have signage in the lobby locating all baby changing stations and restrooms;
- have signage with a pictogram void of gender that indicates the presence of a diaper changing station;
- any non-gendered multi-stall restroom or single-gendered restroom must have signage with a pictogram void of gender¹

To help with compliance the Office of the State Architect received an appropriation to purchase signs to meet these requirements.

II. REQUESTING SIGNAGE FUNDING

Agencies and institutions must complete a Documented Quote process and send it along with the *Restroom Signage Funds Request* found on the State Buildings website on the Procedural Forms webpage. Please download and submit along with the quote to dpa_statebuildings@state.co.us. C/O State Building Program

The State Buildings Program will respond with a draft Purchase Order to be completed by the agency/institution as noted in Section III.

III. ACCOUNTING/FISCAL PROCEDURES

Executing a Purchase Order:

Step 1: Agency completes the signage Purchase Order supplied by OSA and obtains an updated W-9, and a Certificate of Insurance that names the State of Colorado as an additional insured and appropriate coverage.

- **Please ensure that all vendor terms and conditions are removed or struck from their proposal prior to submitting to OSA.** Because the funds are within Department of Personnel & Administration, the Agency cannot enter the Purchase Order into CORE.
- Send **draft** document to OSA for review and approval as well as email addresses of the parties that will be electronically signing and anyone who should receive notification of the executed document
- **OSA will upload for electronic signatures.**

Step 2: Department of Personnel & Administration Financial Services Group will obtain the Authorized Accounting Signature and enter a PO transaction into CORE to encumber the funds against the Signage Request and approve the transaction.

Step 3: Once the encumbrance is executed, OSA will forward the electronic copy back to the Agency.

Preparing a Vendor Payment

These signage payments can only be paid from the OSA Gender Neutral Signage fund. Agencies are not authorized to enter payments into CORE since the money is controlled by Department of Personnel & Administration.

¹ The legislation does not define void of gender

Procedural Steps:

- Step 1:** Receive documentation in the form of invoices, applications for payment, or certificate for contractor's payment. Review the documentation for approval.
- Agency is responsible for tracking spending against the purchase order for the scope of work in the original quote.
 - The signage project number must be referenced on all documents submitted for payment.
 - All pay applications require an accompanying matching vendor invoice.
- Step 2:** Agency is required to note somewhere on the pay request "Authorized to pay", date and initial.
- Step 3:** An original vendor invoice must be emailed to OSA.
- Step 4:** After OSA reviews documentation, they will forward an electronic copy to Department of Personnel & Administration Financial Services Group for entry into CORE.
- Step 5:** Department of Personnel & Administration Financial Services Group will issue a warrant, or EFT, to the vendor.
