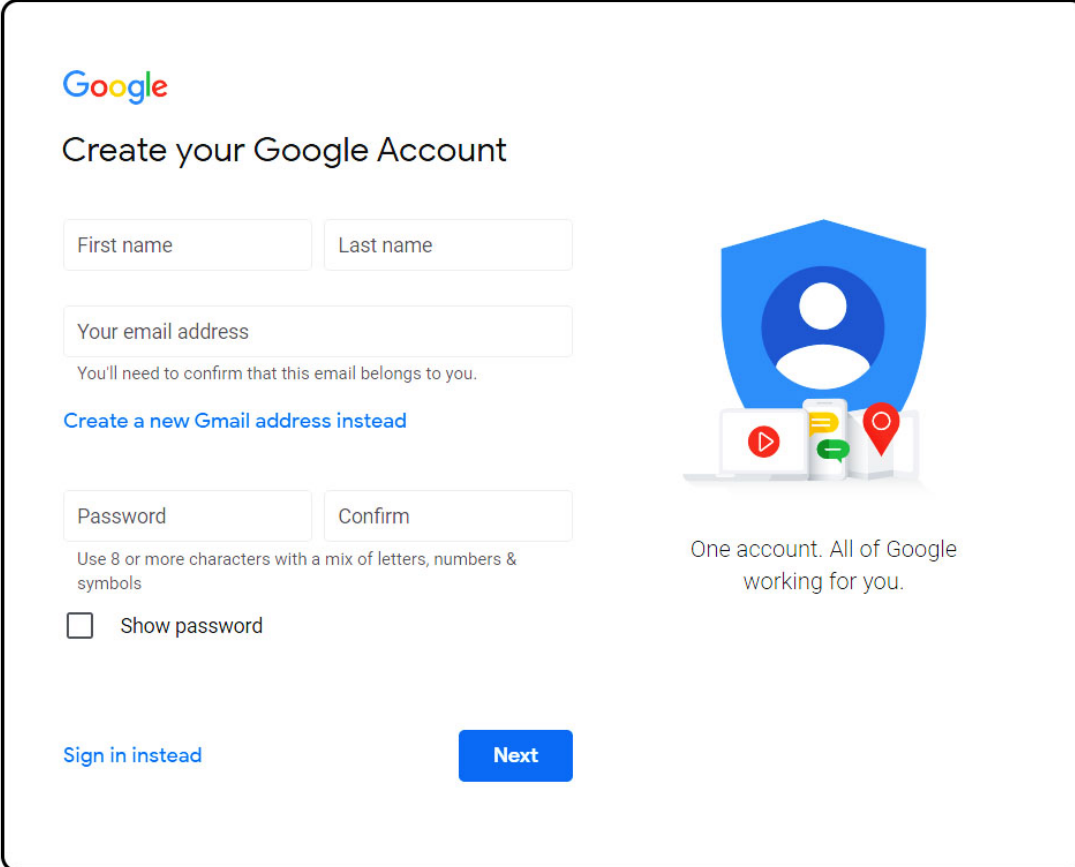


Creating a Google Account

A Google Account gives you access to many Google products. With a Google Account, you can do things like access and collaborate on Google products with other Google users. You are able to create a Google Account with an existing non-Google email address.

To create a Google Account with an existing email address:

1. Go to the [Google Account Creation page](#).
(If you are brought to an error page, Click Next before completing Step 2).
2. Enter your first and last name.
3. Click **"Use my current email address instead"**.
4. Enter your current email address.
5. Create and confirm your password.
6. Click Next.
7. Verify your email address with the code sent to your existing email.
8. Click Verify.
